- Video Size: Aim for a resolution of at least 720p. The maximum file size per upload is 500MB.
- **Title & Description**: Give your video a descriptive title that reflects the topic you are teaching. Write a brief description that summarizes the content covered in the tutorial.

- Encourage students to take notes during your video.
- Suggest exercises or past questions they can try after watching the tutorial.
- Invite them to submit their questions in the comments section or reach out to you for clarifications where needed.

7. Ongoing Updates

As exam trends and topics may change over time, consider updating your content regularly to stay relevant and aligned with new examiner reports or curriculum updates.

8. Compliance & Integrity
